1. The club will be known as The Oxted & District Football Club (Founded 1894) and be duly affiliated to the Surrey County Football Association (SCFA).
2. An Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be convened annually in June with 21 days' notice. The meeting will elect a President, Vice Presidents, Auditor and a committee of 7 members to manage the club which will include a Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Club Captain (4 to form a quorum) with power to co-opt and form sub committees for the better running of the Club. Nominations for these officers and committee members to be made to the Secretary in writing 14 days prior to the AGM. All persons elected shall retire annually but are eligible for re-election.
3. A statement of accounts, duly audited shall be submitted to the AGM for approval and adoption.
4. Rules shall only be made or altered at the AGM or at a meeting especially for that purpose. Proposals, duly seconded, shall be made to the Secretary 14 days prior to such meeting.
5. New members shall not be admitted to membership, or be admitted as candidates for membership, to any of the privileges of membership, without an interval of at least two days between their nomination or application for membership and their admission.
6. Persons becoming members without prior nomination or application may not be admitted to the privileges of membership without an interval of at least two days between their becoming members and their admission.
7. The Club Treasurer and/or appointed Bar Secretary in association with the Club committee (all such members must be aged 18 or over) will be responsible for the purchasing of alcohol and supplies for the Club bar. There will be a price list displayed within the premises.
8. Alcohol will only be permitted for sale to members or guests of the Club who have attained the age of 18 years (when necessary proof of ID will be requested).
9. No arrangements are, or are intended to be, made for any person directly or indirectly to derive any pecuniary benefit from the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of the Club to members or guests, apart from (a) Any benefit accruing to the club as a whole, or (b) any benefit which a person derives indirectly by reason of the supply giving rise or contributing to a general gain from the carrying on of the club.
10. Team Managers to be appointed for all teams and to be responsible for team selection.
11. Up to date record books of minutes by the Secretary or appointed Minutes Secretary, members by the Secretary and cash by the Treasurer will be maintained.
12. Members will pay a Club Membership fee which is payable annually at the beginning of the season. Players will be unavailable for selection for any team until their membership has been paid in full. The level of the fee will be determined by the Club Committee and is variable each season, this fee is non-refundable.
13. Players will be charged a match fee for each game, the level of the fee will be determined by the Club Committee and is variable each season
14. All players must be duly registered on the appropriate league and cup forms.
15. Transfers may only be granted if all commitments to the Club have been met.
16. The Club colours will be red; this kit is provided by the Club for the players use. In the event of a clash in colours a blue kit will normally be used.
17. Complaints from any member should be made in writing to the Club Captain who will raise it at the next full committee meeting.
18. All questions of player indiscipline shall be dealt with in Committee who have the power to suspend a player in addition to any punishment handed out by the SCFA. Any player amassing more than 6 penalty points (1 for a caution and 2 for being sent off) will be required to attend before the committee to explain their behaviour.
19. The Committee has the power to deal with any matters arising which may not be specifically mentioned in these rules.

Respect Code of Conduct for Adult Players

Play your part and observe Oxted & District Football Club's Respect Code of Conduct for players at all times.

On and off the field, I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of The Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote Fair Play
- Always respect the match official's decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Never engage in bullying, intimidation or harassment
- Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach/manager with respect.
- Remember we all make mistakes.
- Win or lose with dignity. Shake hands with the opposing team and the referee at the end of every game

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA.

I may:

- Be required to apologise to team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a warning from the manager
- Receive a written warning from the club committee
- Be required to attend an FA education course
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Not be selected for the team
- Be required to serve a suspension
- Be fined
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club.
